1 WHAT IS MENATROPIN?



Menotropin is a gonadotropin complex derived from human menopausal urine (hMG).

It contains both FSH (Follicle Stimulating Hormone) and LH (Luteinizing Hormone) activity.

It is commonly studied and used in research and clinical practice to support ovarian function, follicular development, ovulation, and overall female fertility.

2 WHY IT MATTERS



FOLLICULAR DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT – FSH activity may support the growth and maturation of ovarian follicles.



OVULATION SUPPORT – LH activity may help trigger ovulation and support corpus luteum formation.



HORMONAL BALANCE – May support estrogen and progesterone production during the menstrual cycle.



FERTILITY RESEARCH – Studied in women with anovulation, PCOS, diminished ovarian reserve, and other fertility-related conditions.



ASSISTED REPRODUCTION – Frequently used in research and fertility protocols, including IUI and IVF, to optimize outcomes.

3 HOW MENATROPIN MAY SUPPORT WOMEN'S REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH



Supports follicular growth and maturation



May help trigger ovulation through LH activity



May support progesterone production



Supports menstrual cycle regulation in research settings



May be used for diminished ovarian reserve research



Often included in fertility and IVF protocols
